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* HISTORY

Murshidabad University (situated on the eastern bank of the river Bhagirathi in Berhampore, Murshidabad, West Bengal) is established by THE MURSHIDABAD UNIVERSITY ACT, 2018, West Bengal Act XVIII of 2018, Part- III, Acts of the West Bengal Legislature, Law Department Legislative Notification, Published in The Kolkata Gazette (Extraordinary), ASVINA 9, Monday, October 1, 2018; and the University started functioning along with the joining of the first Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Sujata Bagchi Banerjee, (Former Principal, Krishnath College, Berhampore, Murshidabad) and Gazette notification No. WB (Part-I)/2021/SAR-248 Dt. 04.06.2021. The first initiative for the foundation of a University in Murshidabad, upgrading Krishnath College (one of the oldest and leading colleges of West Bengal, with a great heritage of 167 years), was undertaken well in 2016 by the people of Murshidabad district. Thereafter, the process of upgradation of Krishnath College into a University named "Murshidabad University", keeping intact the heritage of the college, was initiated by the Govt. of West Bengal. The passing of the Murshidabad University Act in 2018 by the Government of West Bengal paved the way for the required transfer of the ownership of the land and all establishments of Krishnath College by a 'Deed of Gift' to the Government of West Bengal;

In order to formulate the syllabus in accordance with U.G.C. guidelines Regular Board of Studies (BoS) meetings were organized. After receiving 2f status from U.G.C. in September 2021, from October 2021 regular P.G. classes were held. Under the guidelines of the second Vice-Chancellor Dr. Mita Banerjee who took additional charge in February 2022, the functioning of the Murshidabad University progressed further. The examination system became well organized and the faculty absorption process was initiated. Dr Banerjee has been succeeded by Dr Rup Kumar Barman as the third Vice-Chancellor of Murshidabad University for an interim period of three months. The Murshidabad University campus reflects the harmonious multicultures with students from several districts of West Bengal. The University promotes sports, literary and research activities through seminars and webinars and creates space for academic excellence. Now we are following the New Education Policy,2020.

Murshidabad University, library containing roughly 45,000 titles of varied interests is an object of both glory and pride of Bengal. Its ancient collection provokes attraction and envy in many minds. The college extends its accommodation of about 450 students coming outside Berhampore in its three spacious large hostels (two for boys and two for girls).

Murshidabad University marches on its path of present determination, future dream and aspirations to become an internationally reputed temple of learning in the district of Murshidabad with the able leadership of present Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Dr Professor Achintya Saha.
